The Regulation and Quality Improvement Authority gives notice of a proposal to place conditions on the registration of Camlo Homes. 1. The Responsible Person must ensure that a manager is appointed who satisfies the requirements for registration with RQIA as soon as reasonably practicable. This will be kept under review by RQIA. Regulations breached: <i>The Residential Care Homes Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2005</i> <i>Fitness of registered manager</i> <i>Regulation 9.— (2) A person is not fit to manage a home unless –</i> <i>(c) full and satisfactory information is available in relation to him in respect of the matters specified in paragraphs 1 to 7 of Schedule 2.</i> Schedule 2 <i>Information and documents to be obtained in respect of persons carrying on, managing or working at a residential care home.</i> <i>5. Details and documentary evidence of any relevant qualifications or accredited training of the person and if applicable, registration with an appropriate professional regulatory body.</i>	
The reasons for serving this Notice of Proposal are: An inspection of Camlo Homes was undertaken on the 19 January 2021 at which it was identified that the manager's registration with the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) had lapsed in 2006. It was confirmed that the manager of the home was no longer on any professional register. In addition to the regulatory breach outlined above, The Residential Care Homes Minimum Standards (2011), Fitness of the	

Registered Manager, clearly states that the manager must maintain registration with the relevant regulatory body.

Following a meeting at RQIA on 27 January 2021, we were not assured that a robust plan was in place to rectify this. As agreed you submitted further information on 29 January 2021 indicating that the Deputy Manager will now be acting manager. This arrangement will continue until the manager obtains the necessary qualification and registration to resume her role. It is acknowledged that a reasonable period of time will be required to ensure that the manager is able to apply to be registered in respect of Camlo Homes. During this period we have agreed to the alternative management arrangements you have brought forward.

Imposing this condition should ensure that these temporary management arrangements, do not continue for any longer than necessary.

Under Article 19 of the 2003 Order, the Registered Person/Applicant may, within 28 days of the service of this notice, make written representations to the Chief Executive of RQIA concerning any matter which that person wishes to dispute.
