

- 177 Acute Hospitals with EDs in England.
- LPSE-3 had a response from 174 of them.
- England has 204 Liaison Psychiatrists in post.

(needs 354)

- England has 1,605 Psychiatric Liaison Nurses in post. (needs 1,856) (2,301 for all EDs to be Core 24)
- Of the 177, 20 are foremost Liaison services.
