An announced inspection took place on 24 July 2018 from 14:00 to 14:30.

This inspection was underpinned by:

- The Nursing Homes Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2005
- Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety (DHSSPS) Care Standards for Nursing Homes, April 2015.

The purpose of the inspection was to inspect the proposed additional five bedrooms detailed in variation application ref VA010911. The five bedrooms are currently vacant, previously accommodating supported living tenants. The rooms were originally constructed as part of the nursing home and were so registered until de-registration a number of years ago to become supported living accommodation. As such, they are adequately sized to meet current DoH care standards for new homes and extensions including en-suite provision.

The works to the five bedrooms was completed to a high standard and the variation application is approved from an estates perspective.

The findings of this report will provide the provider with the necessary information to assist them to fulfil their responsibilities.

### New bedroom accommodation

The five bedrooms are adequately sized to meet current DoH care standards for new homes and extensions including en-suite provision. Redecoration works have been completed in the rooms which are finished to a high standard.

The areas identified for attention following the previous estates inspection carried out on14 June 2016 RQIA ref IN032229 were fully met and a range of servicing and commissioning documentation relating to the building and engineering services for the additional bedrooms was presented at the inspection.
