Brief description of the accommodation/how the service operates:

This home is a registered Nursing Home which provides nursing care for up to 44 patients. The home is divided into two units over two floors; The Evergreen Unit on the first floor which provides care for people with mental health disorders and the Autumn Unit on the ground floor which provides care for people with dementia. There are bedrooms, communal bathrooms, lounges and a dining room on both floors.

2.0 Inspection summary

An announced estates inspection took place on 8 August 2023, from 11:00am to 12:00am in connection with variation application ref VA012062.

This inspection focused on the newly adapted sections of the premises associated with the variation application to provide enhanced treatment room facilities, reduce a double bedroom to single providing a new single bedroom to retain registered bed numbers, and to provide new external smoking facilities.

The variation is approved from an estates perspective. Final approval is subject to RQIA Care Team approval.

3.0 How we inspect

RQIA's inspections form part of our ongoing assessment of the quality of services. 4.2 The inspection findings

4.2.1 Are the newly adapted sections of the home compliant with the Department of Health's (DoH) Care Standards for Nursing Homes (April 2015) and with other relevant legislative requirements and Approved Codes of Practice (ACOPs)?

Alterations were made to the existing premises to provide enhanced treatment room and to reduce one double bedroom to a single bedroom and creating a new single bedroom to retain the registered bed numbers at 44. Also included in the alterations was relocation of the smoking room to a new outside smoking shelter which was found to be finished to a high standard and equipped with a fixed automatic cigarette lighter which negates the need for lighters and matches to be used and carried. This significantly reduces the risk of inadvertent ignition of flammable materials.

The areas were designed to comply with the current DoH Minimum Standards with regards to area and critical dimensions, and were found to have been constructed and finished to a high standard.

Documentation presented prior to the inspection and forwarded following the inspection indicated that the premises and the engineering services and equipment are installed and commissioned in line with relevant legislation, ACOPs and best practice guidance.

Confirmation of Local Authority Building Control approval of the alteration works was also recieved prior to the inspection.

The fire risk assessment was updated by the Registered Individual to take account of the alterations and additions made to the home.

The variation is approved from an estates perspective. Final approval is subject to RQIA Care Team approval.
