

Who are RQIA?	Who is RQIA?
<image/>	RQIA is the group of people in Northern Ireland that visit wards in hospitals, homes and other services to check that they are good and make sure that they are safe for everyone. RQIA call these visits inspections. The RQIA also talk to patients, these are called Patient Experience Interviews. The people from RQIA that visit the wards and talk to patients are called inspectors. The inspectors that visited the Cloughmore ward were called Alan and Nichola

	After Alan and Nichola visited the ward they wrote a report of what they found and sent it to the ward. RQIA asked the staff that work on the ward and the people that are in charge of the ward to make some changes. These will make the ward better place to be.



Alan and Nichola were concerned that	
Ę	some staff had not completed up to date training
Ę	patients could not attend the gym on a regular basis
Ę	some staff with special training were not able to use their skills
Ę	the ward's rules for managing patients property needed to be reviewed
Ę	the ward did not provide enough therapy for patients
Ę	some staff felt that the doctor did not always listen to them
Ę	patients could not talk to or meet a psychologist during their admission to the Cloughmore ward
What next?	What next?
	After the inspection Alan and Nichola met with the managers from the Cloughmore ward. They are going to write back to Alan and tell him how they are going to fix the problems on the ward and make it a better place for patients. One of the inspectors will visit the ward again
