RQIA is the group of people in Northern Ireland who visit wards in hospitals, homes and other services to check that they are good and make sure that they are safe for everyone. RQIA call these visits inspections. The people from RQIA who visit the ward are called inspectors.

The inspector who visited Inver 4 Ward was called Audrey

A lay assessor called Alan also spoke to patients on the ward.

- looked around the ward
- talked with patients on the ward
- talked to patients' families and carers
- talked to the staff working on the ward
- talked to the people who are in charge of Inver 4 Ward

After Audrey visited the ward she wrote a report of what she found and sent it to the ward. RQIA asked the staff who work on the ward and the people who are in charge of the ward to make some changes. These will make the ward a better place to be.

Ę	The ward environment did not meet best practice standards for Dementia care.
Ę	There were a number of risks in the ward environment. These could be used by a patient to hurt themselves.
Ę	The policy on enhanced observations was not clear.
What next?	What next?After the inspection Audrey met with the staff and managers from Inver 4 Ward.Audrey wrote a report about what she found and sent it to the ward.One of the inspectors will visit the ward again.
