#### Who is RQIA?






### Who is RQIA?

RQIA is the group of people in Northern Ireland who visit wards in hospitals, homes and other services to check that they are good and make sure that they are safe for everyone.

RQIA call these visits inspections. The people from RQIA who visit the ward are called inspectors.

The inspectors who spoke to the patients on Tobernaveen Upper were called Alan (pictured) and Dr Rea.

### Alan and Dr Rea

- looked around the ward
- talked with patients on the ward
- talked to the staff working on the ward
- talked to the people who are in charge of Tobernaveen Upper

### Alan and Dr Rea also

- read some of the notes that the staff write
- looked at some of the forms that the staff fill out

After Alan and Dr Rea visited the ward Alan wrote a report of what inspectors found and sent it to the ward. RQIA asked the staff who work on the ward and the people that are in charge of the ward to make some changes.

These will make the ward a better place to be.

	Patients felt safe and secure;
	The ward staff team worked well to together;
	Staffing levels were good;
	Patients helped plan their care;
	Patients felt that staff were helpful;
	The ward was clean;
	The ward's atmosphere was relaxed;
	Inspectors noticed that staff were friendly and supportive;
Alan and Dr Rea were concerned that	
	The trust needed to review some policies;
	Some patient risk assessments had not been fully completed;
	The ward's ligature safety plan was not clear;
	The ward's dishwasher was broken.
