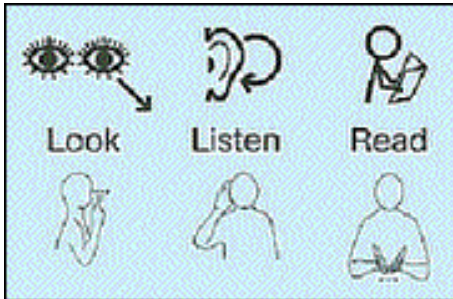

Who are RQIA?

RQIA is the group of people in Northern Ireland who visit wards in hospitals, homes and other services to check that they are good and make sure that they are safe for everyone. RQIA call these visits inspections. The people from RQIA who visit the ward are called inspectors.

The inspector who visited Six Mile Ward was called Cairn.

What did Cairn do?

Cairn

- looked around the ward
- talked with patients on the ward
talked to patients' families and carers
- talked to the staff working on the ward
- talked to the people who are in charge of Six Mile Ward

Cairn also

- read some of the notes that the staff write
- looked at some of the forms that the staff fill out

After Cairn visited the ward she wrote a report of what she found and sent it to the ward. RQIA asked the staff who work on the ward and the people who are in charge of the ward to make some changes. These will make the ward better place to be.
