### 2.0 Inspection summary

An unannounced inspection took place on 30 January 2018 from 14:30 to 15:15.

This inspection was underpinned by:

- The Nursing Homes Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2005
- Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety (DHSSPS) Care Standards for Nursing Homes, April 2015

The purpose of the inspection was to follow up on information forwarded by the RQIA care inspector following an inspection on 30 October 2017 (ref. IN028018). A number of premises related issues were noted as requiring remedial action, the registered manager agreed to address all matters.

The following areas were examined during the inspection:

• Environment

## 4.0 The inspection

#### Environment

- 1. Domestic store wall surfaces were in poor decorative condition
- 2. Sluice room shelving had not yet been installed. Materials on site, but works not yet completed.
- 3. Store room 14 requires shelving and reorganisation. 50% work complete.
- Signage to room doors required throughout home. <u>Note :</u> Registered Manager stated that materials have been ordered, but not yet delivered to site.
- 5. Courtyard ground surfaces and steps require maintenance repairs to prevent the potential of slips, trips & falls.

#### Areas for improvement

Environmental audit should be completed and any necessary repairs/improvements implemented.

#### 5.0 Quality improvement plan
