<p>The Regulation and Quality Improvement Authority gives notice of a decision under Article 20 of the Health and Personal Social Services (Quality Improvement and Regulation) (Northern Ireland) Order 2003 (the 2003 Order) to impose the following condition on the registration of E. McCann Dental Practice.</p> <p><i>Conditions placed by the General Dental Council on the registration of Mr Eamonn McCann must be adhered to.</i></p> <p>Regulations which are breached:</p> <p>The Independent Health Care Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2005</p> <p>Regulation 10 (3) The requirements are that –</p> <p>(c) full and satisfactory information is available in relation to him in respect of each of the matters specified in Schedule 2.</p> <p>Schedule 2, Paragraph 7 -</p> <p>Where he is a health care professional, details of his registration with the body (if any) responsible for regulation of members of the health care profession in question.</p>	
<p>The reasons for serving this notice of decision are:</p> <p>It was brought to the attention of RQIA on 24 November 2015 by the Health and Social Care Board Regional Lead for Governance and General Dental Services, and on 27 November 2015 in a letter from you to the Chief Executive of RQIA, that on 20 November 2015 the Interim Orders Committee of the General Dental Council (GDC) imposed an order that your registration shall be subject to interim conditions for a period of 18 months.</p>	

RQIA has considered the action taken by the GDC. As a consequence of the interim conditions being placed on your professional registration, RQIA has decided to impose an additional condition on your registration (Mr. Eamonn McCann) as registered person of E. McCann Dental Practice (11647).

Under Article 22 of the 2003 Order the registered person may, within 28 days of the service of this notice of decision, make an appeal to the Care Tribunal concerning any matter which the registered person wishes to dispute.
