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**The Regulation and Quality Improvement Authority gives notice of a proposal to impose a condition on the registration of Wood Green Residential Home to cease admissions until full compliance with the issues detailed in the Failure to Comply Notice (FTC Ref: FTC000023E) is achieved.**

**The Nursing Homes Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2005**

**Health and welfare of residents  
Regulation 13**

(4) Subject to paragraph (5) the registered person shall make suitable arrangements for the ordering, storage, stock control, recording, handling, safe keeping, safe administration and disposal of medicines used in or for the purposes of the home to ensure that –


- (b) medicine which is prescribed is administered as prescribed to the patient for whom it is prescribed, and to no other patient; and
- (c) a written record is kept of the administration of any medicine to a patient.

**The reasons for serving this Notice of Proposal are:**

RQIA has issued this Notice of Proposal following limited progress to comply with the actions specified in the Failure to Comply Notice FTC Ref: FTC000023 issued on 7 March 2019 and extended to 5 June 2019 following an inspection on 8 May 2019.

RQIA is concerned that the current medicines management arrangements have the potential to adversely impact on the health, safety and well-being of the residents currently residing in the home. RQIA is proposing to place a condition on the home's registration, ceasing admissions to the home.

Under Article 19 of the 2003 Order, the Registered Person/Applicant may, within 28 days of the service of this notice, make written representations to the Chief Executive of RQIA concerning any matter which that person wishes to dispute.
